1	<p>Prepare two maps showing :-</p> <p>(a) The boundaries and wards of the parliamentary constituency in which the Group Headquarters is situated.</p> <p>(b) The boundaries of the borough or district council and those of its wards and parishes in which the Group Headquarters is situated.</p> <p>The standard of the maps should be such that their Scout Group could use them to beat the bounds should they so desire.</p>			
2	<p>(a) Have studied the system of local government operating in their locality and describe the method of election and the qualifications for voting; and provide proof of their knowledge of this subject verbally or in written form.</p> <p>(b) Show that they have a general knowledge of the Church.</p>			
3	<p>Write a short history (1,000 to 2,000 words) of the neighbourhood in which the Scout lives. It must cover at least 500 years.</p>			
4	<p>Know in general terms the effect of local conditions on either (a) Agriculture, or (b) Industry in the neighbourhood in which the Scout lives. (The Scout to choose the alternative).</p>			
5	<p>(a) Have an elementary knowledge of the sources of English Law or (in Scotland) Scots Law.</p> <p>(b) Know something about criminal procedure, how Civil cases are dealt with and the right of appeal from all Courts.</p>			
6	<p>Produce evidence that they are helping their neighbours, especially those who are handicapped or aged, or is training themselves to do so.</p>
